In relation to the sewerage smell on the new walkway in Ballyhahill and the capacity of the Waste Water Treatment Plant they have asked if the Councillor can provide an eircode of the nearest property to the area of complaint or the name of the Irish Water Treatment Plant in the area so that we can address the capacity query ?

They have also stated that we have not received reports or complaints on the customer system in this regard. Can we receive more precise details please as to the location of the walkway, proximity to the plant , times and dates as there are no reports on file.
