

Limerick City and County Council Social Media Comment Policy

This policy outlines participation criteria by members of the public regarding postings and published commentary on any of Limerick City and County Council's social media channels.

Limerick City and County Council uses social media to share information, gather feedback and create a dialogue with our community. We welcome your input and thoughts, but will not engage with comments or content that includes:

- Abusive or threatening language
- Offensive, indecent or obscene language that could be discriminatory or promotes discrimination of any kind
- Posts of a defamatory or potentially defamatory nature
- Inciting, condoning or encouraging conduct which could result in a criminal offence, civil liability, or otherwise breach any laws
- Plagiarised material; any material in violation of any laws, including copyright
- Private, personal information published without consent
- Information unrelated to the content of the forum
- Commercial solicitation or solicitation of donations
- Spamming in nature
- Trolling or deliberate disruption of discussion

Limerick City and County Council's social media sites are monitored during office hours. While we may post outside of these hours, we are often not able to respond to posts or queries outside of these times.

We welcome feedback and ideas from our followers however we are not in a position to reply to all messages. Comments on our social media accounts will not be considered as contacting Limerick City and County Council for official purposes. Please recognise that these online communities may not be the best way for us to respond to questions you raise and we may ask you to use alternative ways of communicating with us where we think that will be the best way to answer your queries.
