Proposed Disposal of Property at Glensharrold, Carrickerry, Co. Limerick.



### 1. Introduction

The Council own property containing a bungalow on a 0.38 Hectare site at Glensharrold, Carrickerry, Co. Limerick. This bungalow was constructed many years ago as a social house for a man who owned the adjoining farm land. The tenant is now deceased and there is no succession to the Council tenancy. The Housing Directorate had recommended that the property was put on the open market.

### 2. Key Elements of Proposal

The Council received an independent valuation in the range of € 90,000 - € 100,000. The Property was then advertised for sale.

Following a "Best and Final Bids" process, a bid of € 95,100 from Margaret Aherne was accepted.

#### 3. Executive Recommendation to Council
