Response:-



Sites must be shown to be of special interest under one or more of the following headings: Architectural; Artistic; Archaeological; Historic; Scientific; Technical; Cultural; Social significance.

As the Covid-19 restrictions are lifted the standard research repositories, such as the Valuation Office and the Registry of Deeds, both in Dublin, are re-opening to researchers. Over the coming weeks these and other institutions holding files and records will be visited and reports prepared on each of the in places such as these will be accessed and reports prepared for circulation to the Elected Members of the Municipal District.

It is my intention to have this work completed in time for the September meeting of the Adare – Rathkeale Municipal District.
