1. Introduction

There is an area of 87 Square Metres of Land located within the physical boundary of 1, St. Peter Street, Limerick that the Council have legal title to. The land in question has been part of the physical boundary to 1, St. Peter's St. for many years and is not in the possession of Limerick City and County Council.
