Re: Visit to Huy, Belgium July 19-21, 2021 regarding the location, identification and repatriation of Patrick Sarsfield's remains to Ireland.

A Chomhairleor, a chara,

Dr. Pat Daly, Chief Executive and I visited Huy City Council, Belgium 19-21 July last regarding the possible location, identification and repatriation of Patrick Sarsfield's remains to Limerick.

Extensive research undertaken by Dr Loïc Guyon, French Honorary Council to Limerick and Mr. David O'Brien, CEO of the Civic Trust on General Patrick Sarsfield's life following the siege of Limerick has led to an ambitious project to locate and repatriate the remains of Patrick Sarsfield.

Patrick Sarsfield was fatally wounded at the battle of Neerwinden, near Huy, Belgium in July 1693 but his exact burial place has remained unknown since that time. Following extensive research supported by Limerick City and County Council, the French Ministry of Defence Archives and Huy City Historical Records, the possible location of Sarsfield's grave could be near the site of St Martin's church in Huy according to records.

The site of the Church and burial ground is now a residential area and has been purchased by Huy City Council. They have granted permission for an archeological dig to be conducted to secure DNA samples for genetic testing with descendants of Patrick Sarsfield to establish identification. If DNA sampling establishes the remains in Huy are those of Patrick Sarsfield then we could begin the process of repatriation of his remains to Limerick subject to Council agreement.

During the itinerary, meetings took place with the Mayor of Huy (Bourgmestre), Mr Eric Dosogne, Mayor (Bourgmestre) Gino Debroux of Landen (site of the battle of Neerwinden), and their officials. In addition meetings took place with Minister Christophe Collignon, Minister of Local Government and Housing of Wallonia. Official receptions were attended at Huy City Council & Landen City Council along with site visits to St Martin's Church, to the purported burial site and to the site of the battle of Neerwinden (Landen).

We now await the results of the archeological dig so as to progress DNA sampling after which we will be in a position to update Council further.

The European Green Leaf Award is open to all towns and cities in Europe with a population of 20,000 - 100,000 people and following a competitive process, Limerick and Mechelen in Belgium were jointly awarded the title of The 2020 European Green Leaf City.
