Report : Housing for all Conference Oct 29th/31st
Venue Four Seasons Hotel
Cittingford, C. Ruth.

Presentation covered Government "Plan" published
Sept 2nd last; covered as the largest investment
in housing since the 1960's aimed at addressing
the prevailing accommodation crisis nationally.

Covered the pathway to support home ownership
and increasing affordability through support for itself
on moderate incomes in the purchase of their 1st home
with specific reference to the two new affordable
purchase schemes being part of this pathway.

The aim being to deliver homes subsidised at up to
£500K per unit, dependent on both needs location
with the local Authority taking up a 30% stake in the
property.

Other key measures therein will see the rollout of fast
Rental Properties based on the cost of developing, financing
managing and maintaining those homes.

Project to align with the plan will enable the Local
Development Agency to intervene to unlock and accelerate
delivery in the case of slow or stalled developments.

Finally it covered Part V delivery in terms of the altered
requirement making from 10% to 20% for land transactions
after the Act came into force and for all lands from 2026,
as well as the proposed new task to activate vacant sites
for residential purposes replacing the present vacant site
 Levy.
