## **QUESTIONS**

### **3. Question submitted by Councillor C. Slattery**

I will ask at the next Meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick what plans have the Council to deal with the urgent issue of graves waterlogging at Mount St. Oliver and Mount St. Lawrence Graveyards. This matter is very upsetting for people visiting loved ones graves and needs to be addressed as soon as possible. An up to date drainage system needs to be put in place and funds spent on these graveyards.

### **4. Question submitted by Councillor C. Slattery**

I will ask at the next Meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick have the Council any plans to install a pedestrian crossing off the Tipperary Road Roundabout near Chadwick's. There is a crossing at the other side of the Roundabout and a crossing is needed at the Tipperary Road side for pedestrians who walk and run. This crossing is needed as a matter of safety.

### **5. Question submitted by Councillor C. Slattery**

I will ask at the next Meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick is there any plans to erect height limit warning signs at the road access into Boherkyle from the Old Cork Road (R512) and also the road access into Boherkyle from the Old Ballysimon Road? This would help to advise trucks of the height limit of the bridge at Boherkyle, as many trucks have to reverse out and it is causing a safety hazard to the residents of Boherkyle and the motorists that use this area.

I will ask at the next Meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick for an update on the status of Loughmore Canal, Raheen, for details of the water sampling that has taken place there and an update on its current status.
