Notes:

The requirement to publish relates specifically to procurement and not the project so where a project is reported at over €10m the interpretation here is that the project is examined and only the elements of that project that were the subject of a procurement process for a contract in excess of €10m needs to be reported. Therefore, if a project with a total expenditure in excess of €10m is made up of procurements assigning more than one contractor and none of these contracts exceeds the €10m threshold then there is no requirement to include them in the list for publication.
