- Every new Year New Start | read the Adjudication Report and Identify judges feedback & areas to work on
- We analyse our results each year (Not scientific but a worthwhile exercise)
- Online adjudication probably suited US Large Repository of information and photos online. Supplemented by Action Plan, BAP, Website & Social Media Feeds (Facebook, Twitter & Instagram)

# TIPS + ADVICE

#### FOR WHAT ITS WORTH

- Review your scores annually where you are improving | dropping points
- Read the adjudicators report and address their concerns as a priority. Next years judge will read these before their next visit.
- Plan your year ahead + your projects
- Build a good working relationship with your local authority. Adopt the SDG's
- Work with your funding partners to train and upskill your volunteers (eg 5 year action plan)
- Allow enough time and effort to complete your annual submission
- Use all forms of media to get your message out there
- Update your website + embrace Social Media (eg Twitter whole TT community have accounts incl. Adjudicators)
  - Use your social media channels as a diary of your achievements.
    - Take time out to recognise your volunteers (Learn from them feedback | lessons learnt)
    - Highlight + Target a few projects each year (eg Hay Meadows or wildflower verges along road )







## TIPS + ADVICE

#### **REMEMBER:**

- Take a twin track approach Litter picking + Flowers | Administration + Projects in the background (eg Jnr TT)
- Rome wasn't built in a day Build your Brand
- Even the smallest gain is going in the right direction
- You first have to be baptised before you can be confirmed
- Blow your own trumpet No one else will
- Take all the help you can get & don't be Afraid to ask for help. Appoint the right people to the right job
- Build relationships with your LA & External funding partners. Be seen as 'Safe Hands' when it comes to funding ie deliver on your promises.
- Take lots of photos (Before & After)
- Highlight Problem Areas Don't try and hide them
  - Enter Special Award Categories (Helps to Highlight the good work you are doing)
