1.0 Introduction to the Record of Protected Structures (RPS) – Adare-Rathkeale Municipal District

Limerick City and County Council is obliged to compile and maintain a Record of Protected Structures (RPS) under the provisions of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended).

A Protected Structure, unless otherwise stated, includes the interior of the structure, the land lying within the curtilage of the structure and other structures lying within that curtilage and their interiors. The protection also extends to boundary treatments. The RPS contained within the Limerick Development Plan 2022 - 2028 represents a varied cross section of the built heritage of Limerick. The RPS is a dynamic record, subject to revision and addition. Sometimes, ambiguities in the address and name of the buildings can make it unclear whether a structure is included on the RPS. Where there is uncertainty, you should contact the Conservation Officer.

The Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage is responsible for carrying out surveys of the architectural heritage on a county-by-county basis. Following the publication of the National Inventory of Architectural Heritage (NIAH) for Limerick City and County, and any subsequent Ministerial recommendations, the Council will consider further amendments to the Record of Protected Structures. The NIAH survey may be consulted online at www.buildingsofireland.ie

There are 569 no. structures listed as Protected Structures in the Adare - Rathkeale District. The NIAH recommends 173 no. structures to be added to the Record of Protected Structures. The Council will seek to include the NIAH recommended structures on the RPS within the lifetime of this Plan. Useful resources when undertaking works in Architectural Conservation Areas (ACAs), or on Protected Structures can be found in the planning leaflet series available on-line at www.opr.i.e, the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage Advice Series at www.buildingsofireland.i.e, and the advice and guidance on traditional building skills at www.heritagecouncil.ie.
