Chairperson's Report of the Adjourned Travel & Transportation Strategic Policy  
Committee Meeting of 12<sup>th</sup> July 2022.**

The Chair opened the Meeting and welcomed new members Mr. Dean Lillis and Cllr. Tom Collopy. The members congratulated Cllr. Novak Uí Chonchúir on her position as chair and thanked Cllr. Leddin as previous Chair for his contribution on the work achieved through the Agendas of the SPC.

**Item 1: Minutes**

The Minutes of the Meeting of the Travel and Transportation Strategic Policy Committee held on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022 were proposed by Cllr. Teefy, seconded by Cllr. Sheahan (M) and adopted.

**Item 3. LSMATS Update – Mr. Robert Gallagher, Senior Engineer**

Mr. Gallagher gave an update on LSMATS. Following the second public consultation there were 83 submissions. The main topics were rail transport, the Corbally entrance, the setting of challenging and realistic targets and the removal of the LNDR.

The members thanked Mr. Gallagher for the update and referenced the omission of the LNDR from the current draft. Mr. Gallagher added that the executive is actively striving to have the LNDR included in the final draft.

**Item 4. Active Travel Update - Mr. Sean Mc Glynn, A/Senior Engineer**

Ms. Tara Flanagan gave an overview of the current projects in her remit. Ms. Sinead Kennedy then presented on the current NTA schemes and their progress through the various phases. Mr. Terry Brennan delivered a presentation and video on Active Travel communications including –

1. Creating brand awareness
2. Engaging story-telling
3. Selling the Team
4. Community engagement
5. Updates to Elected Members

**Item 5. Active Travel Update on the recent visit to Dun Laoghaire - Mr. Sean Mc Glynn, A/Senior Engineer**


Mr. Sean Mc Glynn updated the members on a recent visit to Dun Laoghaire where ideas were shared regarding Active travel.

The members thanked the Active Travel team for the presentations. Following discussion on individual projects by the members, Mr. Mc Glynn agreed that community engagement is crucial. In response to questions, he added the following:

- There are six-weekly project updates to elected Members and briefing sessions are also held
- There is a project management tool in operation and a report can be generated for all projects and updates given through the SPC
- A brief is currently being drafted for consultants to review emergency services access across Active Travel projects
- The Team will commit to an Active Travel approach to each project in terms of trees and development.
