




Driving Whilst Intoxicated - Limerick




- 4,721 breath tests

- Failure rate 1/130

- 509 Oral Fluid Drug Tests
- 78 drivers returned positive for drugs
- Failure rate 1/7






Limerick Drug Driving - Gender




■ Male ■ Female

Drug Driving Legislation

- Robust and in the main rarely challenged
- Suspect is required to provide a blood sample after arrest
- On conviction Mandatory disqualification from driving

Penalties

- The maximum penalty for drink driving is €5,000 or 6 months in prison or both. Disqualifications range from 3 months to 4 years. Previous convictions result in an increase in disqualification at the discretion of the Court.
- Drug Driving disqualification of not less than 1 year, in the case of a first offence under the section concerned, and not less than 2 years, in the case of a second or subsequent offence. The maximum penalty for drug driving is €5,000 or 6 months in prison or both.
