I will move at the next meeting of the Cappamore Kilmallock Municipal District meeting that Limerick City and County Council Management and Directors of Services conduct a review of Staff and current projects in order to allocate all possible Staff and Skills to Housing Construction and return of voids by prioritising all construction projects.

REPLY:

The Chief Executive has a legal duty to assign staff as appropriate to ensure all services and functions of the Council are met.

The Department of Housing Local Government and Heritage did agree to fund additional staffing for the social housing programme earlier in the year and 5 out of the 7 posts have been filled. The additional 2 posts were of such a level that they were required to be recruited through PAS and we are currently awaiting start dates. In addition, the DHLGH recently agreed to fund 4 staff for Affordable Housing. Recruitment is ongoing.

The delivery of construction projects involves more than local authority staff and is reliant on DHLGH approvals and contractor and materials availability also.
