Metropolitan Municipal District-GMA Special Projects 2019-2024

A Chomhairleoir, a chara,

At the Meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick held on the 15th June, 2020, the Members of the Metropolitan District agreed to allocate the amount of €1.5m to strategic projects across the three Electoral Areas, which would be ring-fenced in the capital account. (These projects are listed in the Appendix attached)

While significant progress has been made with many of the projects identified, some projects have not proceeded due to alternative funding being sourced for a project or a project not proceeding for other reasons.

Following recent consultation and discussions with the Elected Members of the Metropolitan District, it is proposed to instead reassign the GMA funding to alternative projects in the respective Electoral Areas involved, as outlined below:

Original Project	Amount	Reassign To
Raheen / Dooradoyle / Mungret Community Facility	€100,000	Mungret St Pauls GAA Community Hall Extension & Refurbishment Programme.
Construction of Footpaths Garryowen	€100,000	Geraldine's AFC to develop an All-Weather Astro pitch. This facility will be available to St. Patrick's Boys and Girls Schools, Richmond RFC and St. Patrick's GAA. Funding to be held in an account by Limerick City and County Council pending a successful outcome for capital sports funding.

The approval of the Members is required for the formal reassignment of these General Municipal Funding Allocations to the alternative projects outlined above.
