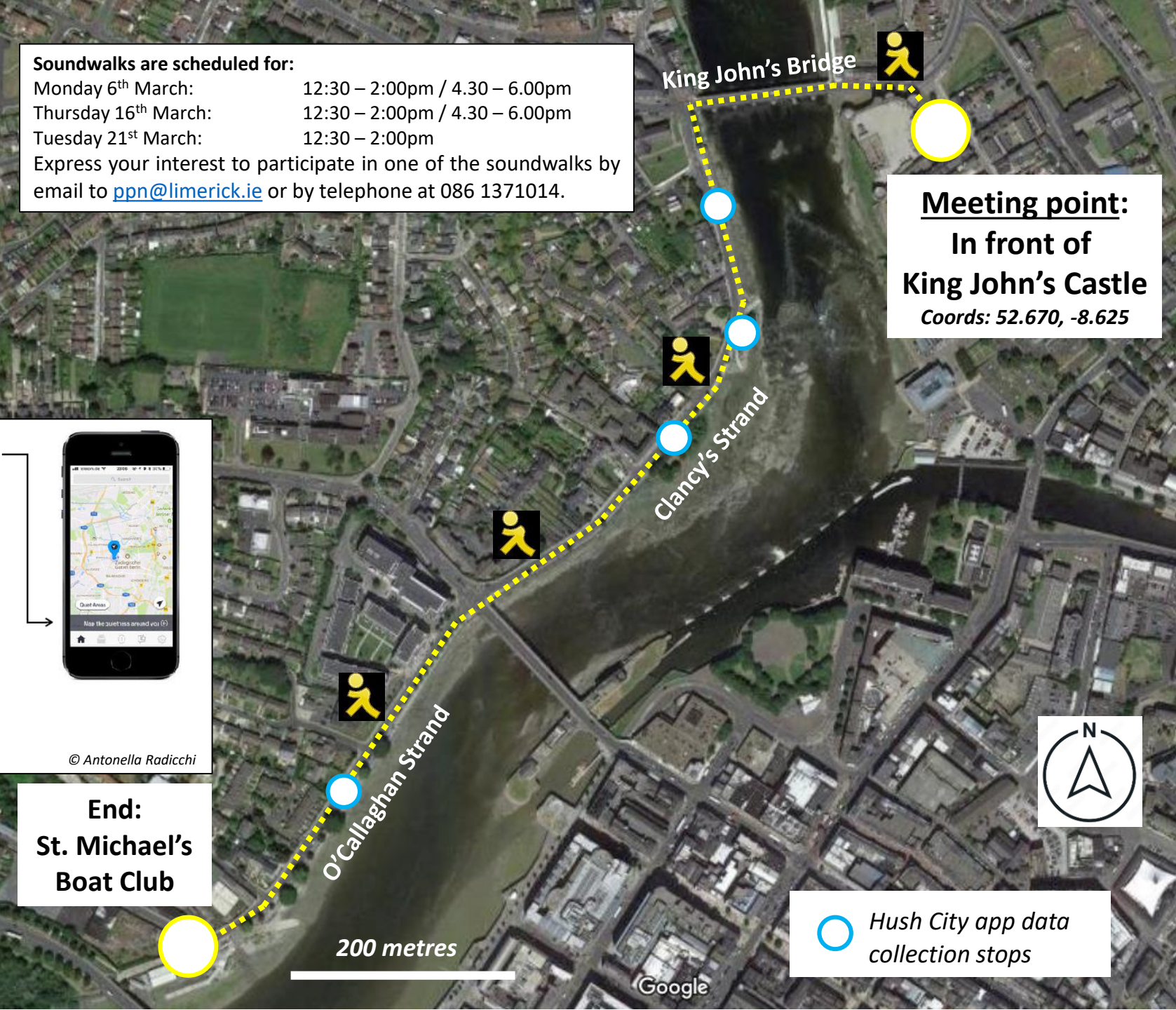


Clancy's Strand and O'Callaghan Strand Soundwalk

Participants are asked to download and use a mobile app called **Hush City**, or fill out a questionnaire supplied by the Council at predefined stops along the route to map the quietness.

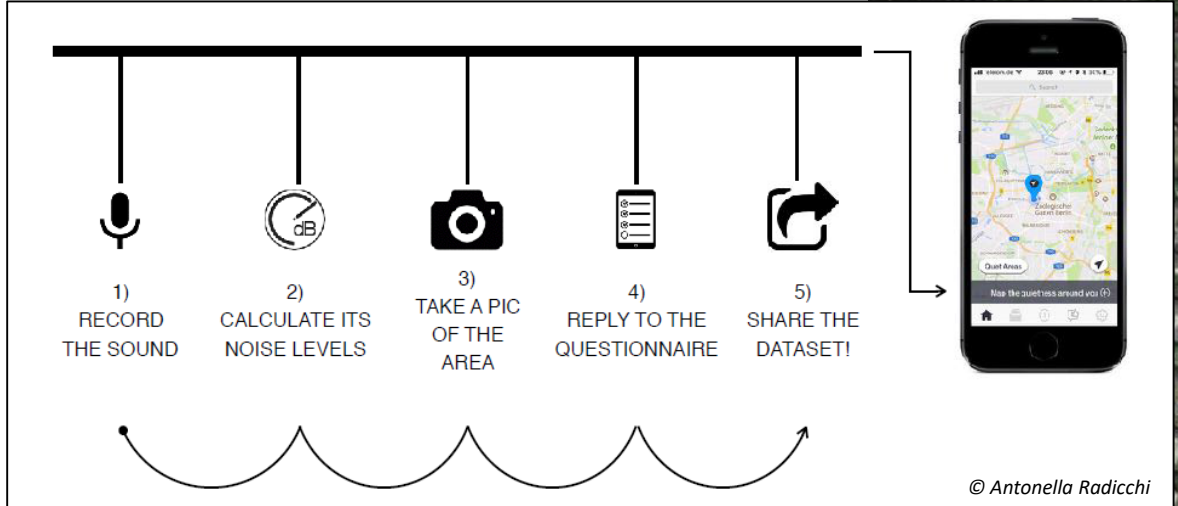
Soundwalks are scheduled for:
