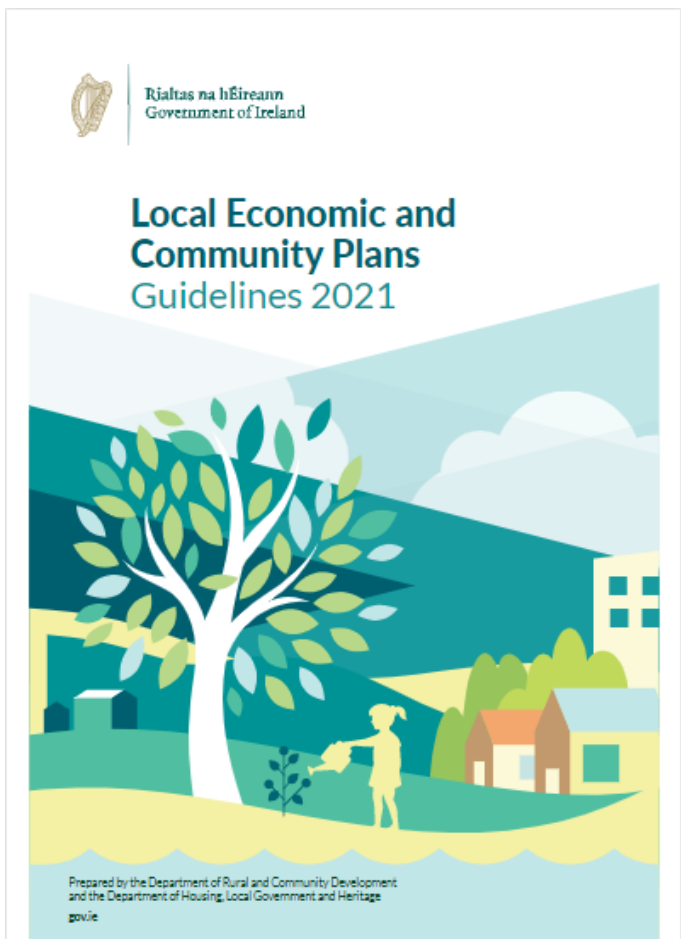

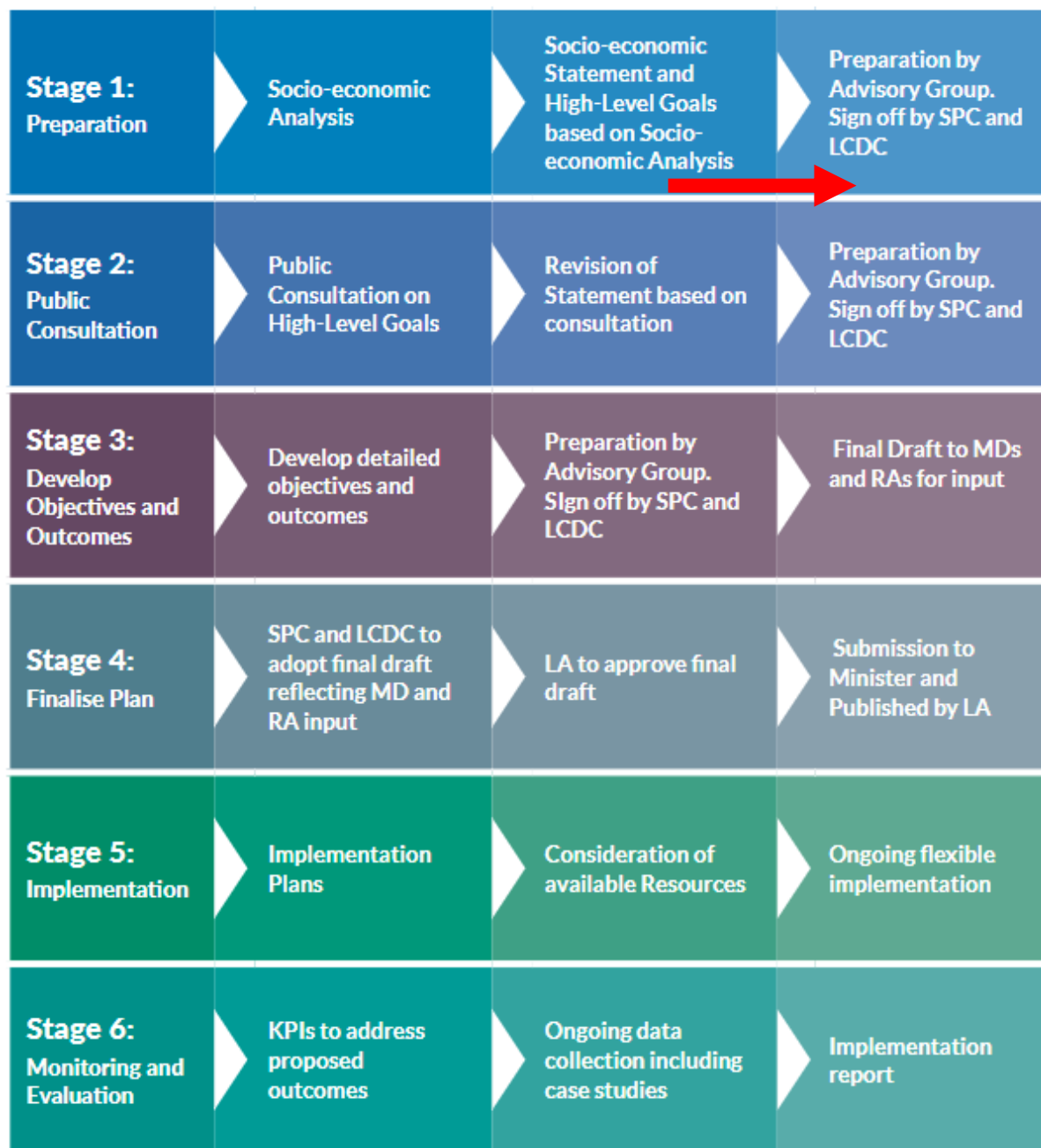

Stage 1: Preparation

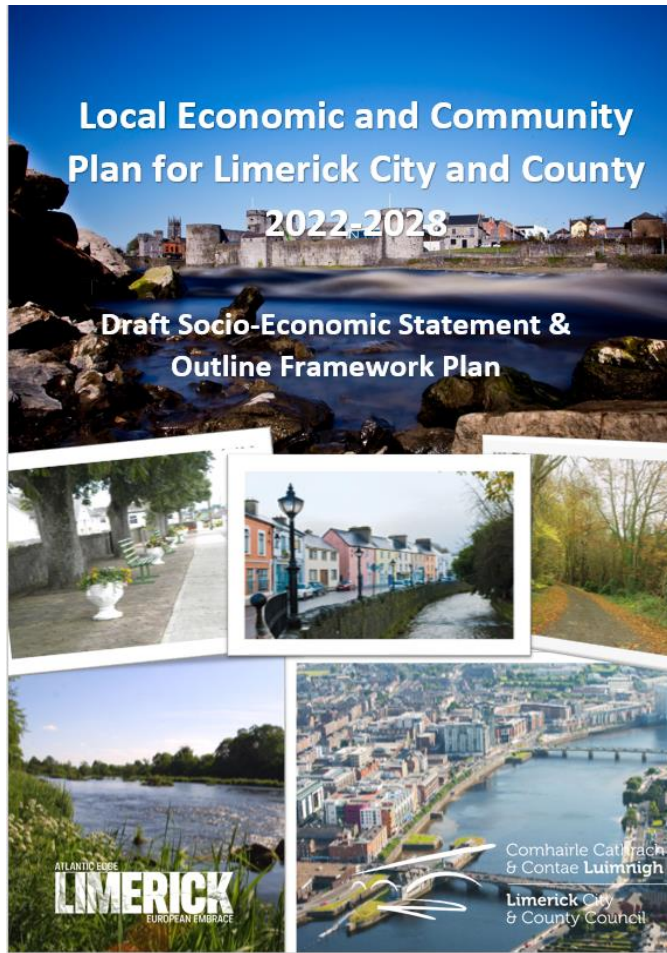
- Full draft Socio-economic statement prepared (November 2022)

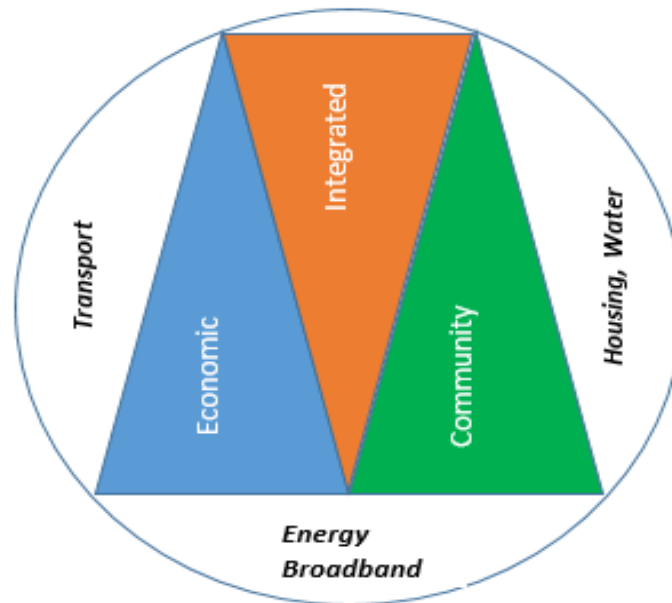

Next Steps & Timeline

Stage 2: Public Consultation process

- From mid-February 2023
- Analysis of feedback & revisions – feed into Stage 3

Stage 3: Detailed objectives & outcomes

- Revisions / further development – **outcomes & metrics**
- LECP Advisory Group – review Draft LECP Framework Plan (April)
- Revised Draft Framework Plan to LCDC & Economic SPC (May-June)
- Review & sign off by Municipal Districts / Metropolitan Area, Regional Assembly (through summer 2023)

Stage 4: Finalise Framework LECP

- LECP Advisory Steering Group – September 2023
- **SEA/AA Screening LECP & report**
- LCDC / Economic SPC sign-off
- Full Council approval (November 2023)

Stage 5: Implementation Plan 2022-2023

- Priority projects for first two-year Implementation Plan – may emerge from consultation & review process
- Timeline – through Summer 2023
- Integrated into Final LECP Framework Plan (end of year 2023)
