I will ask at the next Meeting of the Metropolitan District of Limerick that the Council would undertake analysis of all heritage buildings, bridges and street monuments to enable cleaning of plaques.

Reply:

Limerick City and County Council Road's Department has consulted with the Council's Conservation Officer on this query, who has advised that it is not standard normal practise to clean historical plaques on bridges or monuments. In some cases there may be a separate plaque with an inscription located adjacent to the monument that is legible for the public to read which can be easily maintained and cleaned when required. Each monument is dealt on a case by case basis and any request to upgrade or clean is reviewed with the Council's Conservation Officer. A funding source such as a conservation grant would also need to be determined before any specialist monument upgrade or cleaning works can take place.
