“We will ask at the next meeting of the Cappamore Kilmallock Municipal District if a review of the Disability Parking Spaces in the Municipal District has taken place and if the Statutory process is completed for these spaces.”

REPLY:

Following the motion put down in January 2018, it was proposed to install 15 new parking spaces utilising the green/playing area in Sycamore Drive. This proposal would significantly reduce the only green area in the estate. The Cappamore Kilmallock MD office have identified alternative areas within the estate for the provision of these spaces. The final design is currently being prepared and will be available before the April Municipal District meeting. It should be noted that the installation of these additional spaces is estimated to cost €35,000 and there is no budget available at present to deliver these works.

REPLY:

Responsibility for the delivery of the new Innovation/Hub Facility at the old Bank Of Ireland building in Bruff now rests with Innovate Limerick. Innovate Limerick has commenced the procurement process to appoint a Design Team for the refurbishment of the building and it is expected that this Team will be appointed around the middle of this year.

The exact timescale for when the project will be ready for use cannot be confirmed at this time as the program will be agreed when the design team is appointed and delivery will be subject to planning consent to change of use and grant funding been secured to deliver the entire project. However at this time I would estimate the time frame been in the range of 12 to 18 months.

"I will ask at the next meeting of the Cappamore/Kilmallock Municipal District to get the capacity and load of the wastewater treatment plant in Kilmallock."

Dear Councillor Donegan,

Thank you for your recent communication querying the capacity and load of the waste water treatment plant (WWTP) in Kilmallock, Co. Limerick.

We have received the following response from our Asset management Department:

"We publish waste water treatment capacity registers annually for each county. These registers give an indication of available capacity at Uisce Éireann's waste water treatment plants in the county. The capacity available at treatment plants changes regularly based upon the loads received from existing customers. Our registers are only an indication of available capacity.

The register for County Limerick is available here (<https://www.water.ie/connections/developer-services/capacity-registers/wastewater-treatment-capacity-register/limerick/>) and indicates spare capacity is available in Kilmallock WWTP.

It is envisaged there is adequate capacity available at Kilmallock WWTP to cater for the projected population growth set out in the Limerick Development Plan. In all instances, if you are considering to progress a development, you should contact our Connections team who will provide a greater level of detail in relation to the availability of waste water treatment capacity.
