Pursuant to Limerick City and County Council's standing orders and in accordance with Paragraph 6 of Schedule 10 of the Local Government Act, 2001 (as amended), we the undersigned members of Limerick City and County Council, request that you convene a Special Meeting of the Council to receive a report from the Executive, regarding emergency accommodation capacity in City and County and discussion of same; and to discuss the following emergency motion:

We will move at a Special Meeting of Limerick City and County Council, that this Council;

- notes the recent statement by Threshold which states that: "Unprecedented numbers of adults and children could now become homeless, as a result of the Government's plan to lift the eviction ban for rented properties."
- Limerick City and County Council also notes the statement by Threshold that "the organisation currently works with thousands of individuals with notices of termination, and the Coalition's decision is likely to exacerbate the concerns – and situations – these renters find themselves in."
- Therefore, this Council will write to the Government and appeal to them to reconsider their decision of ending the eviction ban and to liaise with all Local Authorities during this time, to identify and provide all necessary resources required, to assist them in increasing housing supply.
