I will move at the next meeting of the Cappamore/Kilmallock Municipal District calling on Limerick City and County Council to complete the procedure to allow for speed ramps, traffic calming measures and a Set Down area for buses to be installed in the village of Elton to address the safety concerns of the community.

REPLY:

The Cappamore Kilmallock MD will assess existing traffic speeds in Elton to determine if traffic is not adhering to the existing speed limit that is in place through the village.


If a speeding is determined to be an issue, the Cappamore-Kilmallock MD will assess the most appropriate traffic calming measures that would be appropriate.

The Cappamore-Kilmallock MD will also liaise with the Limerick Active Travel Office to examine the feasibility of installing a set down area for buses.

It should be noted that any physical measures that may be identified regarding traffic speeds and the request for a bus set down area will need to be submitted to the relevant funding authority for their consideration as budgets would need to be secured to allow any identified works to progress. In addition, it should also be noted that the implementation of traffic measures requires a public consultation process to be followed.
