

housing developments (excluding single apartment block developments in the city centre) of greater than 25 residential units, that at least 50% of these residential units will be allocated for private market sale through one of the following.

1 Private Purchase

2 Affordable Purchase.

The reason for this is to ensure a balanced tenure mix in all developments that will contribute to settled and sustainable communities.
