RE: Taking in Charge - Declaration of Roads to be public roads.

A Chomhairleoir, a chara,

It is proposed that the area listed below be taken in charge by Limerick City and County Council.

Steamboat Quay, Limerick City

The area to be taken in charge is outlined in red and shown hatched on the attached map (DWG NO.TIC-20-002). Two bays of privately owned car parking spaces to the eastern end of Steamboat Quay are excluded from the Taking in Charge, as shown on the attached map.

In accordance with Section 180 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993 public notice was given of the intention of the Council to consider the matter, drawings of the area were put on public display and submissions were invited from the public on the proposed take-over of the area and declaration of the road to be a public road.

No submissions have been received.

When taken in charge the Council will incur an annual cost of €908 inclusive of VAT for the operation and maintenance of the public lighting in the area.

Your approval is requested for the Taking in Charge of the above-mentioned area in accordance with Section 180 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993.
