2. Subject to Section 6 of the Local Government Rates and Other Matters Act 2019 as amended and in accordance with the Budget adopted, determine, the annual rate on valuation applicable in the calculation of the amount of the rate under Section 3 of the Local Government Rates and Other Matters Act 2019 as amended.
3. To consider the Capital Programme 2024-2026 in accordance with Section 135 (2) of the Local Government Act, 2001, as amended by the Local Government Reform Act, 2014.

Such a scheme in respect of vacant property will provide for an abatement of 10% of rates due to Limerick City and County Council by a liable person for the financial year ending 31 December 2024.
