REPLY:

In order to examine an amendment to the speed limit in this area The Speed Limit Appeals Procedure must be followed. The Speed Limit Appeals Procedure sets out the mandatory procedure that must be utilised by a Roads Authority or National Panel when a member of the public or other interested party raises an objection to a specific speed limit contained within a Local Authority's current Special Speed Limit Bye-laws. A speed limit appeal can be submitted to the roads department of Limerick City and County Council for consideration. Once submitted the appeal is processed in line with the procedure and a decision with respect to any appeal will be made in line with The Speed Limit Guidelines
