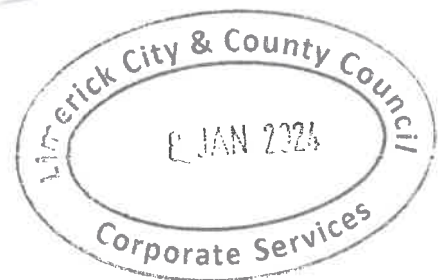
MEETING OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT OF LIMERICK




