



Dear resident,

As you'll be aware, Limerick City & County Council is continuing to progress the construction of Active Travel infrastructure along a section of the Father Russell Road. The project is being funded by the National Transport Authority (NTA).

As part of the continued progress of the works, junction tightening is taking place at a number of locations. This is an effective method of speed reduction for both cyclists and vehicles, in particular whilst making turning movements. This reduction in speed will enhance safety for pedestrians, cyclists and other road users.

At present, while work is ongoing and to protect the safety of on-site workers, turning space for vehicular traffic is temporarily restricted. This will be increased when the junction tightening construction works are completed.

The images on the front and back of this leaflet are artist's impressions of what the works may look like when they are finished.

It is anticipated that junction tightening will be finished in later this month, while the full Father Russell Road Active Travel Scheme is anticipated to be completed in Q3 of 2024.

When completed, the route will facilitate onward Active Travel connections to the city centre. It will enable children to walk and cycle safely to school, as well as providing a safe, segregated facility for residents to travel to work and in to and out of the city centre area.
