**Report: Recommendations from the Assessment Panel: Dolores O'Riordan Music Bursary 2024**

Enclosed is a report and recommendations from the Assessment Panel of the Dolores O'Riordan Music Bursary Scheme 2024.

Dolores O'Riordan, singer, songwriter and lead vocalist with The Cranberries, was one of Ireland's most enduringly popular artists. Following discussion with Dolores' mother Eileen and her family, Limerick City and County Council established the Dolores O'Riordan Music Bursary in 2019, to remember and commemorate the global superstar.

This bursary, now in its sixth year, aims to support a Limerick professional musician in their career development. On 20<sup>th</sup> March 2024 an open call was issued and Limerick based professional musicians were invited to submit applications for the bursary of €4,000, to develop their artistic practice. The bursary closed for applications on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

#### **Abigail Butler**

Abigail Butler is a singer-songwriter from Newcastlewest, County Limerick, who performs and records as 'Abe Soare'. The bursary will enable the artist to record a 12 track album during 2024. Four singles which have already been released to critical acclaim, will be included in the finished LP. The artist has won the Live95fm 'Local Heros' music award and was nominated by Hot Press Magazine's 'Hot for 2022' issue. A graduate of the World Music Academy in UL, the artist has indicated that they are influenced by singer songwriters such as Emma Langford and Wallis Bird.
