This past week 17th to 21st of June

Foundations have been poured at Roseneath for the new boundary wall. In the carriageway outside of Hillside Cottage, services and ducting have been installed and a regulating layer has been poured along with tarring of the area.

Stonework has continued on the wall at the Bishops field and part of the gate for the pillar has been rebuilt in its new location.

Kerbing has been installed between Silverbrook and Laurelville and the footpath area has been tarred.
