Uisce Éireann is continuing efforts to lift the Boil Water Notice in place for customers supplied by Foynes/Shannon Estuary Public Water Supply.

By way of an update for the members of Adare/Rathkeale Municipal District, final commissioning works are progressing at Shannon Estuary Water Treatment Plant in the first two weeks of July with data collation to be presented to the Health Service Executive immediately thereafter.
