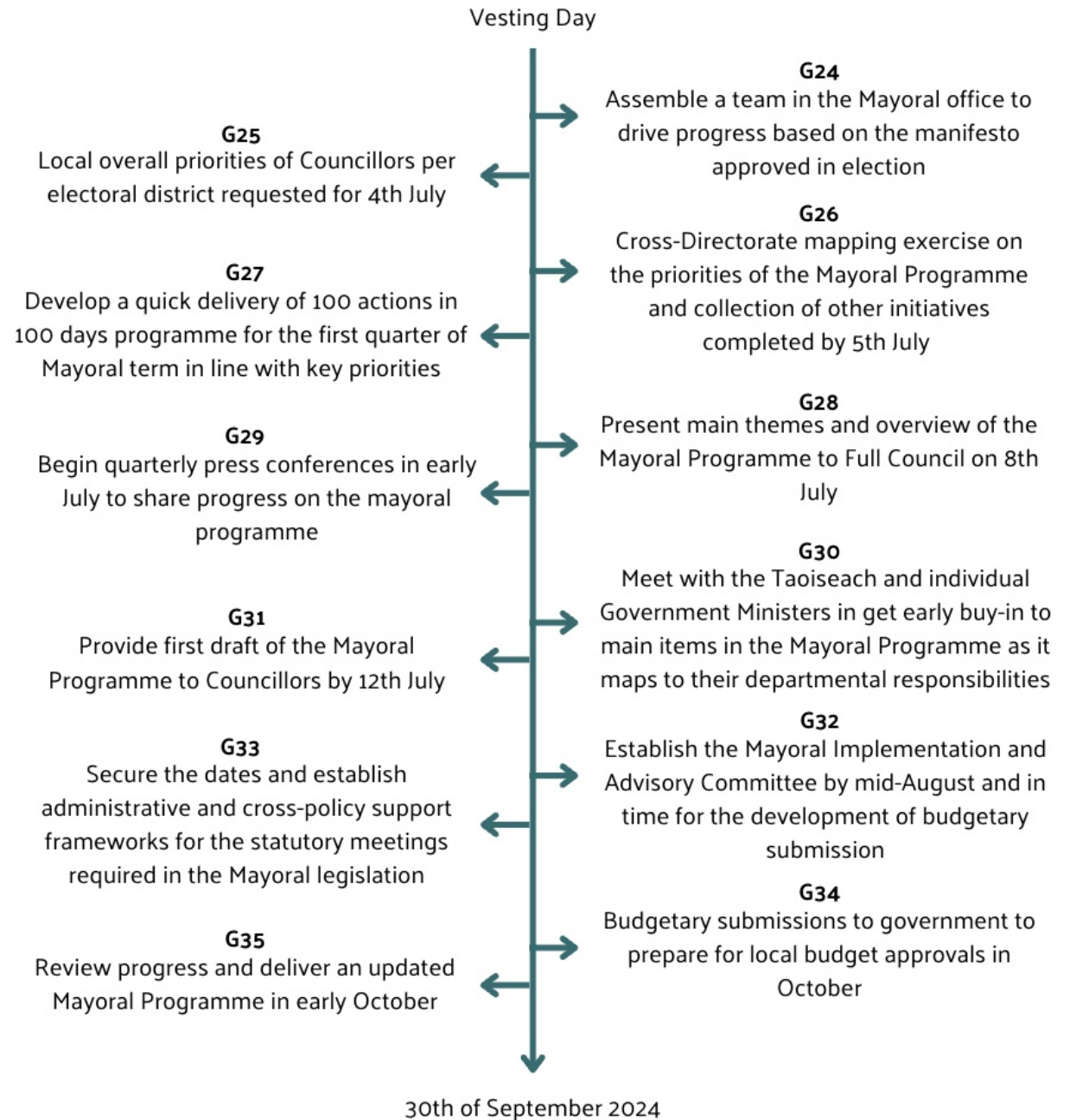

## **CAPPAMORE KILMALLOCK x 14 Asks**

- Public realm plan for Kilmallock
- Promotion of Kilmallock, Kilfinane, Bruff etc. to local airports and Foynes Port with connectivity through the M20.
- Access to Dominican priory
- Promotion of business parks
- Advocate to Uisce Eireann and the Minister for the Environment for the improvement of Water services and waste water services.
- Promotion of water security especially in East Limerick including completing water pipeline at the N24.
- EV charging stations
- Limerick Community Support fund - €100000 provided by the Mayor for events selected by the Elected Members. Not intended to replace GMA money.
- Gardai & rural security – need for local Garda Superintendent based in Municipal district
- Supports for small businesses and enterprises in rural towns and villages.
- Primary care centres.
- More supports to keep people in their own homes – increase of voluntary housing
- Tourism promotion for the region
- Expedition of delivery of private fibre broadband.
