This past week 15th to 19th of July

In the new cycleway/footpath shared space that runs along Scoil Ide, groundworks have been prepped, with the digging of trenches for new kerbs and the area has been backfilled.
Wall capping will continue in the Bishops Field up towards the gate to the Bishops field, the shared cycleway/footpath area in this section will be prepared for tarring.

Aco drains have been installed in Silverbrook houses numbered 5 to 7
2 of the 5 new ducts that are required for ESB services across the Mill Road were installed during night works last week.

Outside Scoil Ide, the new kerbing will be laid in preparation for tarring of the new shared cycleway/footpath. The boundary wall at Roseneath will be demolished along with Laurelville Cottage.

Traffic management will be in place to allow for excavation works to continue on the footpath area for the new shared cycleway/footpath from Laurelville house up towards Laurelville estate.
