The Planning Authority will not investigate complaints of a civil nature, such as those relating to encroachment, private rights of way, trespass, private nuisance and civil boundary disputes etc.

Before making a written complaint, you should ensure that the matter is one within the scope of Planning control. Certain matters, such as complaints relating to roads (parking), water, drainage, Council housing, dangerous structures, environment (litter, noise levels) may be within the remit of other Council Directorates and should be referred directly to same.

Unless the information furnished is decipherable, the form is signed and the name and address of the person making the complaint is given, the said complaint will not be investigated by Limerick City & County Council.
