Declaration of Roads to be Public Roads – Proposed Taking-in-Charge of Castlecourt, Kilmallock, Co Limerick.

A Chomhairleoir, a chara,

It is proposed that the roads in Castlecourt Kilmallock and a portion of the roadway at the entrance to the development be taken in charge by Limerick City and County Council.

In accordance with Section 180 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993 public notice was given of the Council's intention to consider the matter. Drawings of the estate were put on public display and submissions were invited from the public on the proposed take-over of the estate and the declaration of the roads to be public roads.

No submissions were received.

Public lighting will cost €820 per year.

Your approval is requested for the taking in charge of the above-mentioned roads in accordance with Section 180 of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993.
