Re: Proposed Small and Medium Business Support Scheme 2025

Introduction

The proposed Small and Medium Business Support scheme will pay a financial support to occupiers of commercial properties with a total annual commercial rate bill of between €1 and €31,200 in 2025, subject to the Scheme being approved by Council on the basis of the following parameters:

- **The support payment aimed specifically at small and medium-sized businesses will be 17.5% of 2025 rates subject to a maximum limit of €2,000.**
- **Occupiers of formerly Vacant premises would get a 50% Refund of Commercial Rates in the first year of occupation subject to a maximum refund of €10,000.**

Terms and conditions of the Scheme

Applicants must occupy a commercially rated property in Limerick which meets the following criteria:

- Total commercial rates invoice(s) must be between €1 and €31,200 in 2025.
- The Commercial Rates for 2025 relating to the relevant account must be paid in full by 31st July 2025 - this date applies if using any payment method other than Direct Debit.

- Applicants paying by Direct Debit are eligible provided the commercial rates account is paid in full by 31st December 2025.

Exceptions

- Pipeline, Mast/Antenna, Generating Station, Global Valuations and ATM.
- Accounts where the total commercial rates charge is greater than €31,200.
- Vacant Property.

The Council are asked to consider the adoption of the Small and Medium Business Support Scheme 2025 in accordance with Section 66 of the Local Government Act, 2001, as amended by Section 43 of the Local Government Reform Act, 2014 and Local Government (Mayor of Limerick) and Miscellaneous Provisions Act 2024.
