Declaration of Roads to be Public Roads – Proposed Taking-in-Charge of Belfield Crescent Farranshone, Limerick.

It is proposed that the roads in Belfield Crescent Farranshone be taken in charge by Limerick City and County Council.

In accordance with Section 180 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993 public notice was given of the Council's intention to consider the matter. Drawings of the estate were put on public display and submissions were invited from the public on the proposed take-over of the estate and the declaration of the roads to be public roads.

One submission was received. The submission was received from Farron Flaherty and welcomed the proposed taking in charge of Belfield Crescent. The submission raised a number of issues, which are outside the taking in charge process such as traffic calming and parking of vehicles on the footpath

Your approval is requested for the taking in charge of the above-mentioned roads in accordance with Section 180 of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993.
