Next Week - Tarring works on the carriageway

On Monday 9th of December out of hours works will commence to facilitate removal of existing road surface between the old shop and the point at which the Mill Road narrows.

Tarring will commence in these areas on Tuesday and Wednesday next week.

A Stop/Go system will be in place and we are advising motorists to expect delays.

On the evening of Thursday 11th the existing road surface between the road opposite Bishops Field and the entrance to the compound will be removed in preparation for tarring in the following days.

A Stop/Go system will again be in place while these tarring works continue and will result in traffic disruption.
