Declaration of Roads to be Public Roads – Proposed Taking-in-Charge of Crannog, Dublin Road, Limerick.

It is proposed that the roads in Crannog, Dublin Road, Limerick be taken in charge by Limerick City and County Council.

In accordance with Section 180 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993 public notice was given of the Council's intention to consider the matter. Drawings of the estate were put on public display and submissions were invited from the public on the proposed take-over of the estate and the declaration of the roads to be public roads.

No submissions were received.

Necessary public lighting works have been costed at €3,500 including V.A.T.

Your approval is requested for the taking in charge of the above-mentioned roads and services in accordance with Section 180 of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993.
