Community Climate Action Programme

- €60m from the Climate Action Fund has been allocated to the programme over the space of 3 years

STRAND 1:

Strand 1 – Action: Building and Low Carbon Communities (€24m)

Strand 1A – Shared Island Community Climate Action (€3m)

STRAND 2:

Education: Climate Education, Capacity Building and Learning by Doing (€5m – Pobal)

Creative Climate Action (€1m – Creative Ireland Programme)

Community Climate Action Programme

- STRAND 1:
 - Strand 1 – Action: Building and Low Carbon Communities (€811,000)

 - Receive 100% funding
 - Direct climate action projects
 - Be completed in 18 months
 - Supported by Limerick City and County Council

Community Climate Action Programme

Strand 1:

Community Organisation Eligibility

Community organisations meeting the requirements listed below are eligible to apply to partner with the Local Authorities to implement a project under this Programme, they:

- Must be a not-for-profit organisation
- Must be located in the operational area of the Limerick City and Council Local Authority
- Must submit a completed application form on or before the specified closing date and time
- **Must be registered** with a PPN or connected with other collectives such as the Wheel, Tidy Towns and /or a community group with Articles of Association or a Constitution, which hold an AGM, and for which approved minutes are available.

Furthermore:

- The project applied for must be in line with the aim/purpose of the funding as set out in the section on Projects eligible for funding below.
- Only one application per organisation may be submitted for consideration – projects proposed could cut across several of the themes and be bundled together as part of a single application.

Communities not Eligible

- Private individuals
- Commercial undertakings (including sole traders)
- Schools
- National community and environmental organisations

Project Sizes

| Small Scale Projects | Medium Scale Projects | Large Scale Projects |

| Projects Valued at less than €20,000 | Projects Valued in the range of €20,000 to €50,000 | Projects Valued in the range of €51,000 to €100,000 |
| 10% of projects funded will in this bracket | 40% of projects funded will in this bracket | 50% of projects funded will in this bracket |

- Eligible costs = costs submitted for the sole purpose of implementing the project
- Quarterly reimbursements upon meeting agreed milestones
- Project selection numbers is only an estimate and the final selection may vary

A range of projects are being supported, which include solar energy, mini-forests, rewetting of wetlands, a biodigester and food waste initiative and community gardens among others.


