Active Travel Limerick News

“Section 38”

Active Travel Limerick are planning to carry out proposed Section 38 works at **Granville Park (L-10207), Bloodmill Road, Limerick City**

The schemes comprises of the following:

- Install bollards for traffic calming.
- Install planters to narrow the road for traffic calming.
- Install prohibitory signage restricting traffic to “local access only” during school operational times.

- Install new road markings.
- Install new tactile paving.
- Install new footpath and drop kerbs.
- Install new cycle lanes.
- Junction improvements.
- Install table top ramps.

Safe Routes to Schools

“Athea”

Active Travel Limerick Safe Routes to Schools has commenced works in **Athea (R-523)**

The works will include the following road amendments adjacent to **Athea National School**:

- Introduction of chicanes/build-outs on eastern approach to village, as a traffic calming measure.
- Addition of one streetlight plus re-positioning of another one.
- Re-positioning of pedestrian crossing nearer to school gates.
- Reconfiguration of parking spaces outside cemetery.
- Re-positioning of Bus bay and Accessible parking space at front of school.
- Introduction of ‘School Zone’ road markings and pencil bollards.



Safe Routes to Schools

“Murroe”

Active Travel Limerick Safe Routes to Schools are continuing works in **Murroe (R-506, L-1127 & L-1161)**.

The works will introduce the following road amendments adjacent to **Scoil Mhuire Murroe**:

- Enlarged build-out areas/footpaths adjacent to school gates. Introduction of formalised “Type C” raised pedestrian crossing adjacent to school.
- Introduction of two blue badge accessible parking spaces at front of school.
- Reconfiguration of traffic flow around island junction to a one-way system.
- Widened footpath on western approach to junction, with accessible bus stop and shelter.



TUS Moylish to City Centre Scheme

The following works are anticipated to be carried out as part of the TUS Moylish to City Centre Scheme over the coming weeks:

- Pour new footpath sections between **Mayorstone Garda Station and Thomond Park**.
- Install tactile paving at all crossings and junctions.
- Blockwork for new boundary wall at **Thomond Park** to begin August 12th.
- Demolish existing boundary wall at **Mayorstone Garda Station (TUS)**.

Note: Two way traffic will be maintained, apart for very short intervals where plant & material will be going into the works area via the site access points, flagmen will be present during these operations.



Mill Road Scheme

The works at Mill Road are now substantially complete with installation of yellow anti skid outside **Scoil Íde** school and final snagging works outstanding.

Spanning approximately **1.4km** from **Corbally Road to the River Shannon Viewing Area**, the project implemented a range of improvements designed to promote safe and sustainable travel. These included off-road shared pedestrian and cycling pathways. Traffic calming measures such as raised pedestrian crossings and speed ramps to enhance safety for all users.

- Connectivity in a safe manner from the National School at the Eastern end of Loghill to **Woodlawn Estate** with a footpath.
- Associated drainage and public lighting.
- This work ensures connectivity for **Woodlawn Estate** to the Church and village on the N69.
