Proposed Works

The proposed works involves the following road amendment on Convent St, Abbeyfeale, Co. Limerick. Proposed extension of the existing paid parking bye-laws from The entrance to the Secondary school 'Colaiste Ide & Iosef' to a point just beyond the commercial premises of 'Greyhound and Pet World'.

Consultation Period

Road Authority Recommendation

I refer to the email from the Chief Superintendent of Limerick County Garda Division on 23rd May, 2025 and he has no reservations on behalf of An Garda Síochána with respect to this proposal.

I recommend that the Limerick City & County Council Roads Department is satisfied that this regulated paid parking bye-law extension is warranted in the interests of promoting improved road safety, safe access and egress in existing traffic streams to road users and residents of the surrounding areas.
