Bloodmill Road, Windsor Court and Castletroy View Scheme

The work has started on the Bloodmill Road (L-10207) Windsor Court and Castletroy View (L-10539).

The scheme will consist of the following works:

- Junction tightening for traffic calming at the junction of **Bloodmill Road and Castletroy View** including:
 - Kerb realignment.
 - Footpath widening.
 - New tactile paving.
 - Alterations to existing grassed areas.
 - Removal of existing concrete bollards.
 - Removal of existing yellow box road marking.

A temporary traffic management system will be in place at the Bloodmill Road and Castletroy View junction from Monday, 29th September 2025 to Friday, 7th November 2025.

Bloodmill Road, Windsor Court and Castletroy View Scheme continued

Further work that will be carried out on the Bloodmill Road (L-10207) Windsor Court and Castletroy View (L-10539) consists of the following:

- Realignment of existing road marking on **Windsor Court, Castletroy View**.
- Upgrade of existing pedestrian crossing on **Bloodmill Road**, to include for new raised zebra crossing.
- Associated drainage (gully relocations).

A temporary traffic management system will be in place at the Bloodmill Road and Castletroy View junction from Monday, 29th September 2025 to Friday, 7th November 2025.



TUS Moylish to City Centre Scheme

The following works are anticipated to be carried out as part of the TUS Moylish to City Centre Scheme over the coming weeks:

- Footpath Works: Final sections of the new footpaths and entrance area outside Thomond Park will be poured and completed.
- Gas and ESB services will be transferred from the old boundary wall to the newly constructed wall at Thomond Park.
- Cycle Track surfacing: The cycle track will be finished with red tarmac, running from the junction at **Mayorstone Garda Station to Thomond Park Plaza**.

Note: Two way traffic will be maintained, apart for very short intervals where plant & material will be going into the works area via the site access points, flagmen will be present during these operations.

TUS Moylish to City Centre

Scheme continued

The following works are anticipated to be carried out as part of the TUS Moylish to City Centre Scheme over the coming weeks:

- **Ongoing Construction:** Demolition of old footpaths will continue, along with the installation of new kerbing, underground ducting, and construction of new footpaths and cycle track.
- **Knockalisheen Road Junction Upgrade:** Junction works include installing new tactile paving, kerbing, a pedestrian crossing, and new cycle track.
- **Opening of Thomond Park Plaza:** The new plaza area is expected to be opened to the public on Friday, October 3rd.

Scheme Update

The marking out of the proposed road alignment, new kerb layouts, pedestrian crossings etc with temporary road marking paint is ongoing.

Engagement will begin in the next few weeks with the residents association, the Active Travel team and the appointed contractors Shareridge to discuss the works and to answer any questions with works estimated to start October 2025.



Old Cratloe Road/Redgate Road Cycle Lanes Scheme Update

The report with replies to the 45 submissions received from the Section 38 process is being finalised.

Engagement will begin in the next few weeks with the residents association, the Active Travel team and the appointed contractors Shareridge to discuss the works and to answer any questions that may arise with works estimated to start Q4 2025.



Towns and Villages Schemes

Note: The Active Travel team are tasked with providing new and upgraded pedestrian infrastructure across Limerick City & County Council's Metropolitan and Municipal districts.

The following works at have recently commenced in **Kilteely (L505), Co. Limerick**.

The works will include the following:

- Installation of new street lighting.
- New **1.8 metre** wide public footpath.
- Associated drainage works.
- Boundary removal with installation of a **1.2 metre** high fence.

The works included permeability improvement measures to the junction at the intersection of the **L11653 and L1113** such as:


- Removal of the existing ramp and replaced with a new raised pedestrian crossing.
