





Demolition Scope
Demolition of whole structures and elements of retained structures is required to enable the redevelopment of the site. Where buildings and structures are of cultural interest the strategy is to peel back the modern elements to permit site wide redevelopment. This is necessary to address issues such as:

- Unstable structures
- Hazardous materials
- Achieving a safe working environment

The intention has been to minimise loss of historic fabric however this has not been possible in all instances. In a few limited areas removal of historic fabric is proposed to permit the sustainable redevelopment of the site. In this respect, the scope of removal of existing building fabric is specifically concerned with the following objectives:

- to support the consolidation of historic fabric by removing elements that diminish the legibility and management of the early structures;
- to support the proposed Phase II development of the site;
- to remove hazards to future occupation;
- to support and enable future development;
- to allow for designs that support the positive reuse of the site as a whole.
