**Re : Murroe Boher Evry-Gregy sur Yerres Twinning Project**

Murroe Boher has a twinning arrangement with Evry-Gregy sur Yerres in France. Murroe parish entered into the twinning arrangement with Evry-Gregy sur Yerres in 1996. Eyry-Gregy sur Yerres is located approximately 25 kms outside Paris.

A delegation of twenty one people from Evry-Gregy sur Yerres travelled to Murroe on 12<sup>th</sup> September until 15<sup>th</sup> September, 25 and all stayed with host families. The purpose of the visit was to continue long term ties between both areas and learn more about each other's history, languages, foods and cultural activities helping to bond and continue open communication and learning.

The delegation who visited included long term members of the twinning committee, other newer members and those in the community interested in the experience of the twinning. While in Ireland they visited a lot of tourist attractions including Rock of Cashel, Cahir Castle and also University of Limerick and had a tour of Plassey House. They also partook in local events and had meals and visits with various local groups.

It is recommended that Limerick City and County Council fund a proportion of the costs incurred in the transportation of the delegation while here, entry fees to tourist attractions and hosting costs. This expenditure can be charged to the twinning code.

Therefore, approval is sought for the provision of financial assistance in the sum of €1,200 towards the cost of the twinning initiative.
