The preferred option for the Athea Flood Relief Scheme (FRS) was submitted to OPW for formal option approval (PR3) on 15 August 2025. OPW has advised that this remains under review.


In parallel with this review and in anticipation of PR3 approval from OPW, LCCC has continued to advance the final planning design. Subject to OPW formal approval, it is anticipated that the Athea FRS will be submitted for planning consent to An Coimisiún Pleanála in Q1 2026.


I will ask at the next meeting that TII be requested to renew sections of the N21 from South Quay towards Cullinagh.
