ADARE VILLAGE WALKING TRAIL

This gentle 2.3 km looped walk lets you experience what makes Adare so special. It takes you along the banks of the scenic River Maigue, to discover its diverse flora and fauna. Explore some of Adare's most historic buildings, its medieval history, and the iconic picture-postcard thatched cottages, that have become so synonymous with Adare, as you move through the village.

Adare's appeal also lies in its cosy cafés, indulgent dining, and artisan shopping offering, that are not to be missed. For a small village it certainly packs a big punch, enjoyed by international visitors and locals alike.
