

MEETING OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF CAPPAMORE – KILMALLOCK TO BE HELD ON THURSDAY THE 16th APRIL 2026

Notice of Motion submitted by Cllr. O'Sullivan

I will move at the next Meeting of the Cappamore-Kilmallock Municipal District that a review takes place on the traffic survey completed on the R517 (Wood Road, Kilfinane), with the intention of moving out the 60k signs a further 150 metres approx., combined with the installation of driver feedback signs, along with other road safety measures at this location.

Reply:

The 50 km/h speed limit on the R-517 Wood Road leaving Kilfinane currently applies for a distance of approximately 40 metres from the last residential property on Barrack Street. Any extension of the 50 km/h speed limit beyond this point would not be consistent with the Guidelines for Setting and Managing Speed Limits in Ireland, having regard to the change in roadside development, road function, and surrounding environment.

The remainder of the R-517 is subject to the default 80 km/h speed limit, which is appropriate and remains in compliance with the Guidelines for Setting and Managing Speed Limits in Ireland.

A digital speed detection driver feedback unit is currently in place on the R517 Barrack Street/Wood Road on approach to Kilfinane.
