Proposed Visit by Metro Delegation to Tallinn, Estonia – June 2026

A Chomhairleoir, a chara,

An invitation has been received from the International Visits and Diplomacy Department of the City of Tallinn for a Limerick delegation to visit to learn of Tallinn's work in developing a citywide Building Information Modelling (BIM) implementation plan that supports the full building lifecycle, permitting processes, and urban planning, with a strong focus on data driven decisionmaking, efficiency and cross departmental collaboration.

In addition, they have offered to showcase Tallinn's digital city services and e-governance solutions on how digital tools are used in practice to improve service delivery, transparency, and citizen engagement at the municipal level. Moreover, they have offered to demonstrate *Soft Academy*, a City of Tallinn initiated programme that develops digital and technology skills through practical, project-based training, strengthening both the public sector and the local innovation ecosystem.

In accordance with Section 142(5) of the Local Government Act, 2001, as amended, the approval of the Council is hereby sought for this proposed visit with an estimated cost of €1,500 per person.

Subject to approval of Council, it is proposed to send a delegation of five Elected Members and two officials to Tallinn (via Helsinki) with the visit proposed to take place from June 10th to June 12th, 2026 inclusive.
