I will ask at the next meeting of Cappamore Kilmallock Municipal District that, having regard to EV charging points currently being introduced in the Municipal District at: Municipal District Offices, Kilmallock/Sycamore Drive, Bruff/The Square, Caherconlish/Monastery Road, Doon; are there plans to roll out EV Charging Points to more towns and villages across the Municipal District? If so, what is the timeline for the provision of same?

REPLY:

The installation of EV charging points at Kilmallock/Sycamore Drive, Bruff/The Square, Caherconlish/Monastery Road, Doon are currently progressing. These installations will be monitored and reviewed to establish usage data when the chargers are operational. A programme for further installations is being developed and will include data available from the existing network locations. Further locations for the next installations will be discussed with ZEVI and will be progressed subject to approval and available funding.

I will ask at the next meeting of Cappamore-Kilmallock Municipal District for a timeline and costings to re-build a fallen section of a wall at the back of Dromin Graveyard.

Response to Question

In early February 2026, a section of Dromin Graveyard boundary wall collapsed. This section has been made safe, until such time as appropriate restoration work can be commenced.

It is envisaged the restoration works will commence in the first quarter of 2027.

Based on similar projects, we currently estimate the cost of the works will be in the region of €10,000 to €15,000.
