TUS to City Centre Active Travel project



What Has Been Done

Bellefield Gardens / Belfield Court

- Road resurfacing works have been completed along Bellefield Gardens.
- Bellefield Gardens has reopened to two-way traffic.
- Works continue on Belfield Court, where the road closure remains in place.

Sexton Street North

- Works are underway at the pedestrian crossing near Thomond Pharmacy.
- Construction of a new footpath, cycle lanes, and new planting and public spaces is progressing.

Hassett's Cross

- Construction activities have moved to the former Hassett's Cross yard site as works progress through the area.

Gaelscoil Sáirséal

- Works have commenced at Gaelscoil Sáirséal.

- Initial works are progressing to widen the existing footpath, providing more space for people walking and cycling.
- The project will also deliver a new pedestrian school entrance and improvements to the school frontage.



What Is Coming

Sexton Street North / Hassett's Cross

- Works will continue between Thomond Pharmacy and Cross Roads junction to complete the inbound side, works will then transfer to the opposite side of the road and continue in the Hassetts Cross direction.
- Construction of the new footpath, cycle lanes, planting and public realm improvements will continue over the coming weeks.

Gaelscoil Sáirséal

- Upcoming works will include relocating the school boundary wall and entrance gate, providing new planting, and extending the existing School Zone measures towards Hassett's Cross.
- Once complete, the scheme will provide safer and more accessible routes for pupils, families and the wider community.
